## Friends of Oxleas Woodlands

### **Woodland Conservation**

Our work is varied and no special skills are required; all ages and abilities will be welcomed. We build dead hedges to protect areas, improve paths for walking, do stream and pond clearing, clear invasive species, coppice and reduce brambles. Some tools are provided by the Park Rangers but you must bring your own gloves.

The Shooters Hill Woodlands Working Party (SHWWP) meets on the second Saturday of the month at Oxleas Café. Starting at 10am this sociable group works through to about 1pm with a tea-break. Tools, tea and biscuits, are provided by the Council and a ranger is on-hand to offer experience and advice.

The Friends of Oxleas Woodlands continue the Woodland Conservation on the first and third Fridays after the SHWWP session. We collect tools from the Oxleas Centre at 10am and again work until about 1pm with a refreshment break.

### **Rose Gardens**

Our first major project was the restoration of Castle Wood Rose Garden. Volunteers reclaimed the beds, filled them with fresh compost and planted 265 new roses - but the work hasn't stopped there.

Our volunteers continue to meet twice a month, one Friday afternoon and one weekend morning per month (alternating Saturday and Sunday to provide maximum opportunities for you to get involved). We meet in either Castle Wood or Jack Wood rose gardens depending on whichever one most needs our attention that week, so we recommend letting us know you intend to join us so we can provide directions or meet you in a car park.

The work is generally light and only requires gloves and a small hand fork (we can loan these if required). Other useful tools like hoes and edging shears can also be used if sitting on the floor is not for you. You do not need gardening experience, but any you do have is very welcome as we are all learning as we go.



Working in the rose gardens is particularly rewarding as we have the opportunity to interact with park users who often reminisce about their memories of rose-scented summers.

### Litter Picking - more fun than it sounds!

A friendly group of volunteers meet each month, on a Wednesday and Saturday morning to work together for a couple of hours to clear different areas of the woodlands of all kinds of rubbish. We mainly pick up routine litter such as bottles and food wrappers but on occasions also need to remove garden waste or larger items. We provide all the equipment you need although it is best to bring your own gloves. We have cleared literally tons of litter from the woodland and by doing this have removed threats to the wildlife and plants within the woodlands; as well as making it a more pleasant place for everyone.





#### Fundraising

The restoration of the Castle Wood rose garden to its former glory with the communal planting of 265 roses was only made possible through the generous support of Members and the public for the fundraising campaign which included sponsoring a rose and events such as Gardeners' Question Time and pruning master classes.

We have ambitious plans for improving the woodland pathways from 2022 onwards, and while some of the work can be carried out by volunteers, we will also need to employ specialist contractors and equipment. We will need to fundraise to pay for this work, so if you have experience of organising fundraising events, filing in funding applications or would just like to become involved in this please let us know.

For 2022, FOW has moved from an annual membership fee to a donation-based approach to funding our running costs and projects. If you are able to make a donation either now or later in the year, it would be greatly appreciated.
